<p><b>1st Quarter</b>          Intro to Computers, Keyboard Skills, Internet, Introduction of Drawing Program (Kidspiration, KidPix, Tux Paint, Paint), Mouse control, Internet safety</p> <p><b>Introduction to the Lab:</b> rules, review basic mouse and keyboard skills.</p> <p><b>Internet Explorer:</b> explore Starfall website, Game Goo, and other academic websites.</p> <p><b>Drawing Program:</b> help them start the program and navigate the simpler tools. Move on to drawing simple figures.</p> <p><b>Online safety:</b> Netsmartz or similar</p>	<p><b>3rd Quarter</b>          PowerPoint, Folder Structure, Digital Cameras, Internet Explorer</p> <p><b>Folder Structure:</b> locate/open/close/save a document.</p> <p><b>Digital Cameras:</b> take pictures for class PowerPoint</p> <p><b>PowerPoint:</b> Joint projects with classroom teachers – e.g. Plant seeds, document growth with digital pictures and student drawings, make classroom PowerPoint presentation of the process.</p> <p><b>Internet Explorer:</b> <a href="#">District's Reading Skills Program</a>, <a href="#">Game Goo</a>, <a href="#">Starfall</a></p>
<p><b>2nd Quarter</b>          Graphic organizers, General Computer Knowledge (desktop icons, etc.), Word, ), Ethics- Review the Internet Acceptable Use Policy in the Student Handbook, Internet Explorer</p> <p><b>Graphic Organizers:</b> Kidspiration or similar</p> <p><b>Internet Explorer:</b> <a href="#">District's Reading Skills Program</a> (Letter Recognition, Group A and B of Fry's 500 Most Frequent Words) Explore <a href="#">Game Goo</a> website. Have First Graders start in the Beginner area (blue), and have them progress into Intermediate area (purple) and Advanced area (pink). <a href="#">Starfall</a></p> <p><b>Word:</b> holiday letters, invitations, cards; letters and sentences; writing and illustrating math story problems, tools icons (insert picture, and word art)</p> <p><b>Digital Camera:</b> have students take</p>	<p><b>4th Quarter</b>          Word, Excel, Internet Explorer</p> <p><b>Word:</b> write poem/story and illustrate with clip art/word art</p> <p><b>Excel:</b> Create a template for the students to input data.
